General Cocktail Information

Cocktails and dinner are in different locations:

Cocktail hour is on the lawn next to the actual glass house where the ceremony then reception (after a room flip) will take place. We'll need a mic and speakers for the ceremony, a set-up on the lawn, and then pianos set up in the glass house during cocktail hour

Expected number of guests for cocktails: 36

Location of the Couple at this time: 10-15 minutes of alone time post ceremony; introduced into cocktail hour after

Music (Recorded) for cocktails: Modern and classic upbeat and fun; songs that get people in the dancing mood (We have a short list of songs for inspiration)

Other Details: -Bride and groom would like to be introduced into cocktail hour rather than the reception
Introduce them as "The Newlyweds, Paige and Matt" - "If I were a fish" by corook

-When cocktail hour ends we're hoping that the performers can begin playing to draw guests from cocktail hour (on the lawn) back into the glasshouse for dinner (not sure if this will work if we're not starting the show portion right away. Would like to chat through this with you!)

We will do a little mini set to get people inside. Not everyone has a seat inside, so we're just drawing them in as quickly as possible to do cake cutting etc.

Chef will speak at the end of cocktails before we move people inside. Give him a mic.
