12:15pm - This is the "ceremony". It will only last for 10 minutes, the bride and groom will exchange vows on the patio. Fade out background music. Please play instrumental piano only of "I Will" by The Beatles. Keep vamping throughout the 10 minute ceremony as the vows are exchanged.

12:30pm - Solo Piano Show. Take requests, make sure your sound is coming through venue speakers. Please stick to songs no older than the 80s, and please emphasize upbeat danceable party songs!

2:30pm - DJ Set. Keep taking requests. Performers will eat during this time. Heavy heavy hors d'oeuvres will be available until 3:30pm. Please finish the live show, queue up some DJ songs, and then take turns eating during this time frame.

4:00pm - Last song, End of reception!
