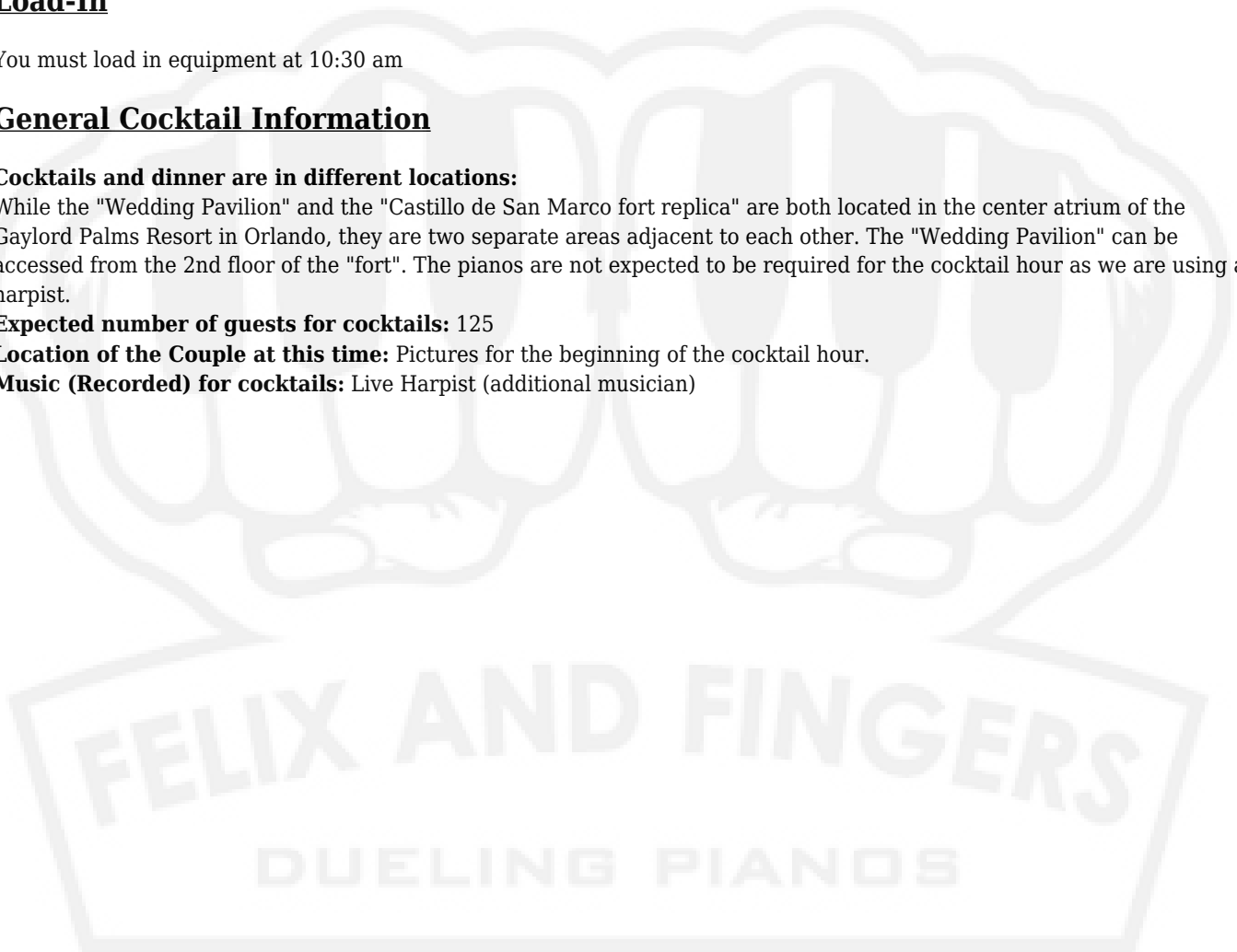
Cocktails and dinner are in different locations:
