This wedding requires an outdoor setup.

Rain Plan: The ceremony will be outside. The immediate area by the ceremony space has no shade but there is a shaded patio at the back of the ceremony space. We can talk through which location makes the most space for the players as we also believe the outlets will be available in this shaded area, but we need to confirm with the venue. We will still need the sound system to reach the officiant. The cocktail hour will be a mix between indoor and outdoor, but having the music come from the reception space would work for quieter background music. The dinner and reception will be inside with air conditioning.

In case of inclement weather, the ceremony will be moved inside where the reception is taking place. The ceremony and cocktails are at the same venue but NOT in the same area.

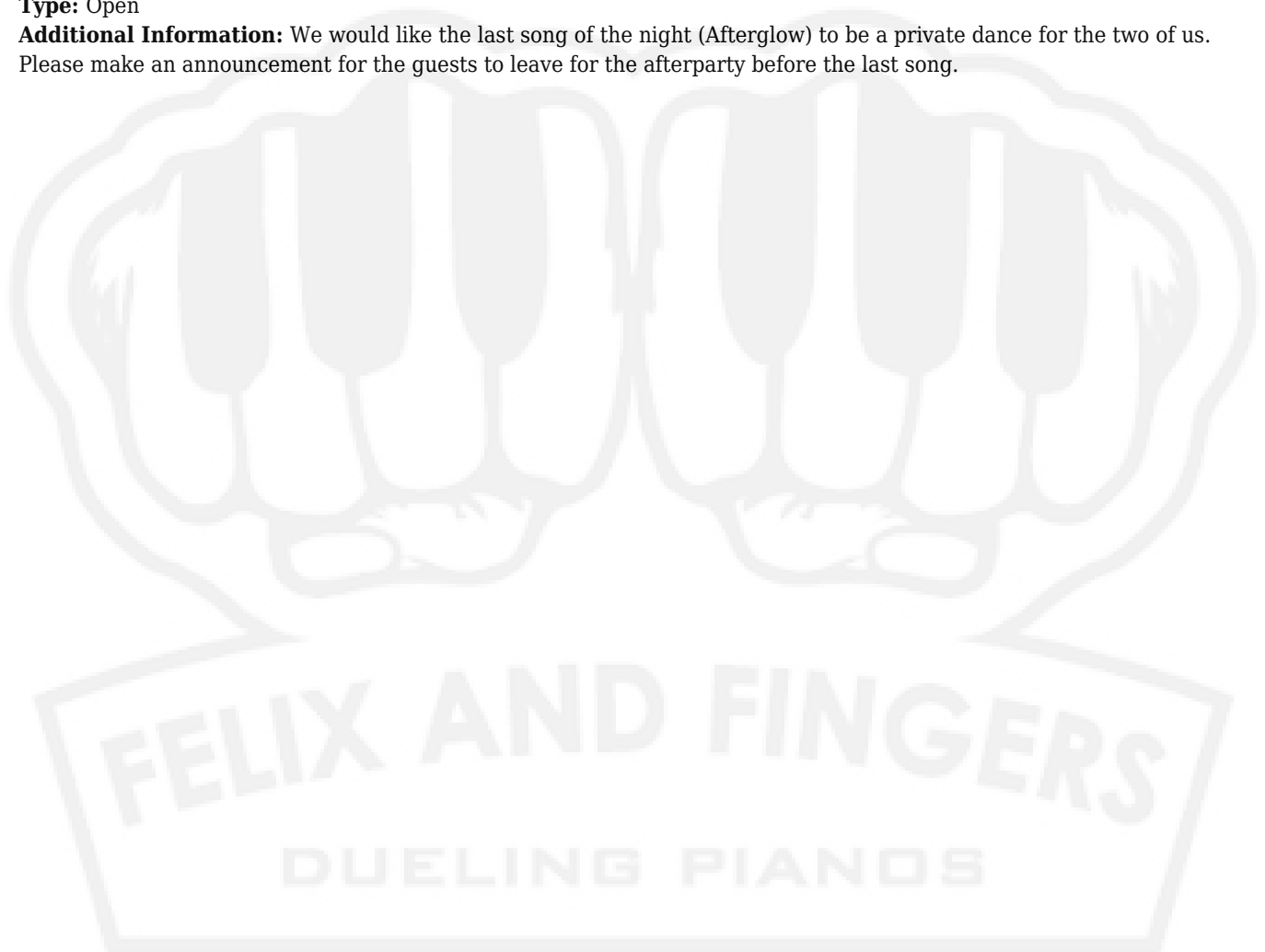
