5:30pm	Showtime	Presenters start the show and get audience involved. Since this is a fundraiser, presenters encourage donations to play songs throughout the performance. We will have "Song Request" forms on every table and performers will encourage attendees to utilize these request/tip forms to get their favorite songs played. Small dance area is available.
7:45pm	Last calls	Presenters announce that the show is ending soon (at 8PM) and thank/encourage people to donate.
8PM	Show ends	Thanks and goodbyes
